

Only officially passed motions of the Commission are binding on the CEO.

1. Decisions or instructions of individual Commission members, officers, or committees are not binding on the CEO except in rare instances when the Commission has specifically authorized such exercise of authority.
2. In the case of Commission members or committees requesting information or assistance without Commission authorization, the CEO can refuse such requests that require, in the CEO's opinion, a material amount of staff time or funds or are disruptive.

Only the Commission acting as a body can employ, terminate, discipline, or change the conditions of employment of the CEO.
