The job of the Commission is to represent the public in determining and demanding appropriate organizational performance. The unique contributions of the Commission will be:

- 1. The link between the Grande Prairie Airport and the people of Northwestern Alberta.
- 2. Written governing policies which, at the broadest levels, address the following:
  - Ends: Organizational products, impacts, benefits, outcomes, recipients, and their relative worth (what good for which needs at what cost).
  - Executive Limitations: Constraints on executive authority which establish the prudence and ethics boundaries within which all executive activity and decisions must take place.
  - Governance Process: Specification of how the Commission conceives, carries out and monitors its own tasks.
  - Commission-CEO Relationship: Delegation of authority and monitoring
     of performance. Determination of the CEO's role, authority and accountability.
- 3. Assuring appropriate Grande Prairie Airport performance through a structured process of monitoring the CEO's compliance with Commission policies.
- 4. The link between the Airport and elected government officials, consistent with messages agreed by the Commission as a whole.
